



Stories: True or False?

The word “story” often gets a bad rap. When we hear that word, we often think of fictional accounts that weave events that never really happened into a larger tale, but stories can also be true accounts of real history or fictional accounts set in a historical context. This is called historical fiction; while the details of the story might be made up, they are reasonable given what was going on in the world at the time.

For example, the Ark Encounter in Kentucky, built by Answers in Genesis, tells stories set in the context of the true account of the global flood. The Biblical account is true, but because some of the details of the ark are unknown, Answers in Genesis weaves a story that fits what we do know from Scripture and captures the imagination of visitors.



At the Glendive Dinosaur & Fossil Museum, we also want to weave stories that are consistent with



the true history found in the Bible. While what most people know about dinosaurs comes from stories like “Jurassic Park,” we want to point people to the truth we see in the Bible and in historical accounts of dinosaurs. One of our new exhibits, brought to life by our artist, Melanie Richard, tells a story of a malnourished “dragon” terrorizing a human settlement. The “dragon” is fashioned after the *Dracorex hogwartsia*, which is a type of *Pachycephalosaurus*. The goal of the exhibit is to get our visitors to consider that dragon legends are actually accounts of dinosaur sightings. If the earth is about 6,000 years old, and dinosaurs lived alongside humanity as mentioned in the Bible, such sightings would be expected.

We’ve also been working on expanding our Order of Burial display, which shows how a global flood event would explain the fossil record.

While we may not have all the details correct, we want it to be consistent with the truth of the flood account in Scripture. Our hope is, as visitors view the exhibit, that they will consider the true history found in the Bible.

Ultimately, we want people to trust God’s Word as the source of truth, especially when it comes to their standing before God as sinners in need of the Savior, Jesus Christ.
